Christian Science Lesson Sermon

"Mortals and Immortals" will be the subject of the Lesson-Sermon in all Christian Science churches on Sunday. The Golden Text is from Romans (8:19), "The earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God."

The immortal status of the children of God will be emphasized throughout the sermon. Paul explains this immortal status in his epistle to the Romans, "For as many are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. . . . The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God; And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and Joint-heirs with Christ" (8:14, 16, 17).

"Christ presents the indestructible man, whom Spirit creates, constitutes, and governs," declares Mary Baker Eddy in "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures." In another passage she says, "Human capacity is slow to discern and to grasp God's creation and the divine power and presence which go with it, demonstrating its spiritual origin. Mortals can never know the infinite, until they throw off the old man and reach the spiritual image and likeness." (pp. 316, 519)
