
Indians in Final Clash Before Detroit Series

The Los Angeles Lakers have announced the completion of plans for a unique summer tryout camp, to be held the week of June 12 in Los Angeles. The camp will be for the purpose of giving the Laker coach a good look at various rookies from the draft list.

Said Coach Fred Schaus, in announcing the camp, "We will invite a limited number of boys who have never played in the NBA to come to Los Angeles and will spend a week working them out in closed sessions. This will give us an extensive opportunity to look at rookies without the distractions of the usual basketball training sessions. Those boys who look like solid prospects for NBA basketball will then be invited back to the regular Laker training camp in September."

The closed sessions will be held twice a day at Pepperdine Men's Gym, under the personal supervision of Schaus.

Last year, when their training season opened, the Lakers took twenty-two men to camp, and it was felt then that having so many boys on hand not only hampered the work
