

## El Camino Opens Summer Schedule on June 19-21

With 157 classes, ranging from art to zoology, on its program, El Camino College will open its 1961 summer session on June 21.

Registration for summer work will be completed on June 19 for current spring students of the college and on June 20, when new and former students will sign for classes. Enrollment will be held in the student activity building from 1 to 3 p.m. and from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m.

Twenty classes in English will be offered, including basic English, reading development, reading and composition, survey of English literature, great American writers and modern American plays.

Next in numerical sequence will be mathematics, 19 classes offered in elementary, intermediate and college algebra, plane geometry, plane trigonometry, plane analytical geometry, differential calculus, integral calculus, a third course in calculus and engineering slide rule.

**OTHER FIELDS**  
Other fields prominently represented in the course offerings are art, business, chemistry, history, music, political science, psychology and speech arts.

Course work is also offered in auto mechanics; biology, cosmetology, drafting, engineering, French, geography, geology, German, health education, home economics, phil-

osophy, physics, power sewing, radio electronics, refrigeration and air conditioning, Spanish, theater arts, welding, zoology and biological science.

Work will be offered during morning and evening hours. Schedules for the summer program are currently available in the registration office of the Administration Building, 16007 South Crenshaw Blvd.

## Keep Medical Card Handy, Says Campaign Chairman

The personal medical record card, included in the appeal letter of the current crippling respiratory disease campaign, can save your life, Dean L. Sears of Torrance, 1433 Post Ave., local campaign chairman said today.

Specifically designed to be carried in purse or wallet, the medical record card was included in the fund raising appeal letter mailed to local residents last week by the Tuberculosis and Health Association of Los Angeles County.

Throughout the month of June, the pioneer voluntary health agency in our community is soliciting funds for the support of medical research, health education and community service projects in the area of chronic respiratory diseases, Sears said.

### KEEP AND USE

"I would urge all Torrance residents to keep and use their personal medical card and also to answer their appeal letter as soon as possible," Sears added. "In case of accidents or other emergencies, the data listed on the personal medical record card could be of great assistance to the attending physician."

Sears added that chronic respiratory illnesses now account for approximately one-fourth of the man hours lost to industry. It is estimated that 33,000 people in this area are suffering from some chronic lung ailment.

"Science has just begun to uncover some of the answers relating to the diseases of the respiratory tract and progress in this area of medicine can be of great benefit to all residents of our community," he concluded.

## Vacationers Should Leave Consent for Emergency

Parents who plan to take vacations this summer, and leave children at home with a friend or baby sitter, have been advised by South Bay medical spokesman to make sure the children's guardian has written consent of guardianship in the event a medical emergency occurs.

Dr. Arnold C. Niemeyer, chief of staff of South Bay Hospital Redondo Beach, said consent forms may be obtained at South Bay Hospital by requesting them at the information desk, 514 N. Prospect Ave. (Prospect Ave. and Diamond St. or by requesting them over the telephone, FRontier 3-3434.

Dr. Niemeyer said there are many forms of medical attention which cannot be given to a minor without the consent of a parent, since the minor is legally too young to consent.

### EMERGENCIES

For most emergency treatments which may be necessary, however, a parent can authorize a temporary guardian to give consent to a doctor or hospital emergency staff to do the necessary treatment.

Dr. Niemeyer said the request is being made at this time due to the advent of summer, and the usual increase in accidents which occur during summer vacation months.

He said that South Bay physicians find the lack of proper consent at the right time a continuing frustration, with the result that young patients sometimes are caused discomfort and delayed medical attention.

Consent will stop short of permission to allow "elective" surgery, he explained, but will empower a physician to go ahead with medical care he deems reasonable and necessary for total recovery in the routine accident situation.

Dr. Niemeyer also was careful to explain that the lack of consent will not prevent a physician from doing his job in a life-or-death situation.


South Bay Hospital will supply interested persons with two forms. One form should be sent to the family physician, and the other should remain in possession of the temporary guardian, to be shown to the physician or hospital emergency staff.






