"Fly the Flag" Program Launched by Marina Federal Savings President

Flag program headed by Russell Chase, President and Manager of the Marina Federal Savings and Loan Association, has been launched in the Centinella-South Bay Area with an initial presentation of 50 star flags to each employee of the association. Chase, recalling the unquestioned duty of Americans when he was a boy of displaying "old Glory" on all national holidays, conceived of the "Fly the Flag" program, and in his words, "resolved that efforts be made to see that the new 50 star flag of the United States be displayed in renewed honor for the unity and independence which it symbolizes.

The campaign is designed specifically to remind citizens that an integral part of the flag code of the United States as set forth in a provision passed by Congress, 1942, is today in danger of fading from actual practice. It is the duty of the citizens of the

United States to display the flag in front of their homes and places of business whenever possible on special days, including: New Year's Day, Jan. 1; Washington's Birthday, Feb. 22; Easter Sunday, variable date; Jefferson's Birthday, April 13; Mother's Day, 2nd Sunday in May; Armed Forces Day, 3rd Saturday in May; National Maritime Day, May 22; and Memorial Day, May 30 (flag at half-staff until noon, then full staff).

Flag Day, June 14; Independence Day, July 4; Labor Day, 1st Monday in Sept.; Constitution Day and Citizenship Day, Sept. 17; Columbus Day, Oct. 12; Veterans' Day, Nov. 11; Thanksgiving Day, 4th Thursday in November; and Christmas Day, Dec. 25.

The flag also is flown on other state and special holidays and at every polling place on election days.

This Marina Federal idea met with such response that expansion of the program is now well underway. Flags will be presented to local clubs and civic organizations to stimulate increased official display. The first flag presentation of this kind will occur at a dinner held on Flag Day, June 14, at the new building of the Los Angeles Press Club

on North Vermont, when Russell Chase will present a large 50-star auditorium style flag to the club.

During the dates from June 28 through July 3, Centinella-South Bay area Mariners and Sea Explorers will be on duty in the foyers of both offices of Marina Federal Savings and Loan Association in Westchester and Torrance to give out American flags to adult citizens who request them for proper use. Appropriate for house display, these flags will be 3 x 5, 50-star flags.
