### John Beeman Receives Doctorate Degree in Medicine This Month

Dr. John A. Beeman, son of Dr. and Mrs. John W. Beeman, 1518 El Prado Ave., was awarded the degree of doctor of medicine by George Washington University, Washington, D.C., at the annual commencement this month.

Dr. Beeman received the degree of Bachelor of arts from the Occidental College in 1958.

Degrees were conferred on 1,205 graduates by University President Thomas H. Carroll. The graduates—870 men and 335 women—represented 46 states and ten foreign countries.

James Webb, administrator of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, was the commencement speaker. "Dream no little, dream," Webb told the graduates.

"Before the third quarter of this century is over" Webb

said, "I suggest that the gigantic Nova booster, with a thrust of 12 million pounds, will rocket three men to the moon and have enough additional power to return them to earth."

"You as a citizen, as a future parent, as a patient in a hospital, will benefit from space exploration in your daily life," he added. We dare not lose this contest, and I want to state my conviction that we shall not lose it," he ended.

The Academic Procession was led by Dr. John F. Latimer, university marshal. The invocation and benediction were given by the Right Reverend James Flavius Madison, Rector of St. Ann's Parish, Annapolis, Maryland.

### Gardening Therapy Proves Successful

Therapeutic gardening is contributing greatly to the recovery of a considerable number of psychiatric patients in hospital for veterans in the area, according to Lowell Like, manager of the Los Angeles VA Center.

In the process, two and one-half acres of formerly barren wasteland have undergone landscape transformation and became one of Southern California's most beautiful garden spots.

Much more important than the aesthetic value of this beautiful spot, however, said Like, is the invaluable service the work of building the area has been in the rehabilitation of patients.

#### RESULTS

Again and again the results of this therapeutic program have paid off in the recovery of all types of mentally ill patients who otherwise might still be in the depths of mental illness.

The patients, with professional guidance, do all the work themselves.

The project over the years has included the building of waterfalls, colorful fish pools, shaded picnic areas, floral displays of rare flowers, a hothouse, and a main barbecue area.

#### AROUSES INTEREST

It has aroused the interest of landscape firms, builders of pools, and lovers of flowers.

These people teamed with volunteer donors to give the needed knowledge and financial impetus.

Garden therapy is one of the newer approaches to long-range patient treatment programs and is an accepted therapy in many hospitals throughout the country. At the Los Angeles VA mental hospital, it has become an activity which is medically prescribed and professionally guided to help patients meet their emotional needs.

#### RESULTS OF WORK

Through the program, the patient is given an opportunity to be outside and away from the wards. He has a chance to work with his hands, and most important, to

see the results of his work. The results give the patient a feeling of pride and accomplishment, creating within himself a sense of belonging.

The program is important, too, in teaching him how to work with others toward a common goal.

The barren, muddy land that was to be seen a few years ago is now a garden with a waterfall that cascades into a series of pools; a place abounding in flowers, shrubs, and trees; a place where many other patients, not in the garden program, are able to walk and relax and to spend time with relatives and friends.
