

EXPLORING GILBERT & SULLIVAN

The nature of satire during the Victorian Age, with particular reference to the works of Gilbert and Sullivan, will be the subject of Dr. Herman Harvey's psychological study on "The Touch of Fame," today 3:30 to 4 p.m., on KNXT, Channel 2.

Sir Arthur Sullivan, an English composer who could play all the band instruments at the age of 8, and sir William Schwenck Gilbert, brilliant satirist and artist, became famous with their witty musical comedies of the 19th century. Dr. Harvey discusses the circumstances that brought them together, and the events that led to the breakup of their partnership.

Gilbert and Sullivan collaborated on such hits as "H.M.S. Pinafore," "The Pirates of Penzance," "The Mikado," "Yeomen of the Guard," "Iolanthe" and "The Gondoliers." Sullivan's music will background Dr. Harvey's commentary.

"The Touch of Fame" is a weekly presentation of KNXT and the University of Southern California. Dr. Harvey, Associate Professor of Psychology at USC, hosts the series. Producers are Dr. William Stedman of the University and Joe Sands for KNXT Public Affairs. Mike Cozzi directs.

"HEARTBEAT OF FRANCE"

France today is a major power in Europe: In spite of that, three million Frenchmen in less than fifty years; in spite of the devastation of some of France's richest provinces; in spite of defeat, occupation, economic collapse, the breakup of her colonial empire, internal political convulsions, and disillusion with the values by which people have lived — in spite of all this, France has survived some of the greatest catastrophes in modern history. France has been called "the sick man of Europe." But, stubbornly, France has refused to die.

"The Heartbeat of France," to be seen Saturday, August 5, 10 to 11 p.m. over KABC-TV, Channel 7, examines some of the main factors that contribute to the endurance of this complicated and paradoxical nation. Internal pictures important aspects of the French character, the national personality, the current mood in France, and a society in which the individual remains dominant.

The program highlights the lives of three families: Andre Fortin, farmer of the Loire Valley; Robert Badoux, artisan of Le Marais; Gilbert Roger, industrial worker in a suburb of Paris. We look at life in a typical small provincial town, Blois, in Marseille, and in a little-known Quarter of Paris.
