Insomniac Holds Over Artists Inman and Ira

Inman and Ira, dynamic singing team featured at the Insomniac in Hermosa Beach nightly except Mondays, began their entertaining career drawing 75 cents for each person who came in to watch their show.

Since that humble beginning, the pair has signed a recording contract and has appeared in top entertainment spots as well as many concerts and folk festivals.

Ira Rogers and LaRoy Inman, who recently signed a contract with Columbia Records, present an almost understated presentation of heritage or folk music which traces the history of the Negro race. They include chain songs, spirituals and street cries as well as vending songs.

Both of them seem to know their subject well, drawing from a background obtained during childhood in Chicago's south side. They grew up amidst the cries and shouts of the street, the moods of the spirituals of their locale, and the lamentations of friends in the neighborhood.

The songs presented by the pair are drawn from an amazingly vivid understanding of life which came from a broad work background. Both Inman and Ira have work experience ranging from janitorial duties to lead roles in dramatic productions.

Since the time they played their initial professional appearance for 75 cents per person, the pair has been engaged at Chicago's Gate of Horn and the Playboy Lounge.

The pair, which has been at the Insomniac since early summer, has been held over for another four weeks because of wide approval and acclaim in the South Bay area.

Music of Present

New faces in music of the present era will be explored by pianist Roger Williams, trumpeter Al Hirt and the Belafonte Folk Singers when they combine their unique skills in a scintillating "Music for Tonight" program especially designed to exploit their individual artistry at 8:30 Monday through Saturday nights, Aug. 14-19, in the Greek Theater of Los Angeles.

Williams, who has played concerts to capacity audiences in over 150 cities across the United States and Canada, has a unique musical message to deliver. "For years, there has been a gulf between popular and classical music, and I hope to build a bridge across that gulf," he declares. "I think it is more the result of tradition than desire on the part of the public. People who genuinely enjoy good music can appreciate the best in both classical and popular."

Bearded, jovial, exciting Al Hirt brings his bewitching trumpet to prove his standing as one of the greatest exponents of his instrument. His virtuosity runs the gamut of several styles to emphasize a wide range of variety and dynamics.

A new concept in concert presentations will be proffered by the Belafonte Folk Singers, an electrifying 12-man vocal attraction that bears the name of its organizer, Harry Belafonte.


