

Correspondent-Lecturer To Address Congregation

John Morley, award-winning correspondent-lecturer, will be guest speaker at the 11 a.m. service this Sunday in the Redondo - Torrance Church of Religious Science, located at 907 Knob Hill Avenue, Redondo Beach (Prospect and Knob Hill). "Religion Behind The Iron Curtain" will be his subject.

Morley's distinguished career includes 22 trips to headline areas around the world. His lectures emphasize the

feelings, thoughts and attitudes of the peoples of the world, which are often contrary to news reports. He maintains an office in Moscow, and knows Russia well. Morley is a confidant of world leaders, and cultivates the confidence of the people as well. His writing appears in national magazines. He writes a syndicated newspaper column and has been named one of the world's finest lecturers.

Minister Seeks Volunteer Work For Convention

"Help wanted—1,000 volunteer workers." This announcement was made by Leonard Olliff, presiding minister of the Torrance congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses.

According to Olliff, volunteers will be needed from all crafts and trades to transform Candlestick Park at San Francisco into a place of worship for the United Worshipers District Assembly, August 29 to September 3.

Many from the local congregation have offered to fill out the volunteer service form which was handed out by the presiding minister. The form will then be sent to convention headquarters and processed by Wayne M. Knott who has the responsibility of seeing that each applicant is placed where needed.

"Since there will be over 50,000 in attendance at Candlestick Park, many from Torrance and other communities of the state, we will want to make their stay a pleasant one," the presiding minister said, adding that, "the entire family can receive maximum benefit of the assembly when all can be accommodated comfortably and efficiently."

A complete cafeteria and dining room as well as book rooms, first aid facilities and information, will be among the 20 departments that will be set up and manned by volunteer workers. The six-day program will feature Bible discourses and dramatizations designed to help each member of the family live in harmony with Bible principles.

Former Army Man Presents Movies To Congregation

Cris Ketner, son of Mr. and Mrs. Elton Ketner, 1604 W. 224th St., Torrance, is at home after three years in the U.S. Army. The first two years were spent at Fort Ord and Camp Roberts, Calif. and Aberdeen Proving Ground in Maryland. After a 15-day leave at home, he left by air transport for Korea, where he spent 13 months.

Ketner showed his collection of color slides Friday evening, August 4 at the Seventh-day Adventist Church, 1610 Acacia Avenue, Torrance, and gave first-hand information on conditions in Korea.

His work there was twofold in that he encouraged his home church to assist financially in the orphanage program and influenced men in the armed forces to share with those less fortunate than they.

His camp was located 20 miles north of Seoul, where the Adventist Church has a large mission field. He feels that the personal contact made with the missionary personnel in foreign fields is of definite educational and lasting value to service men.

The slide pictures gave a personal insight into the poverty and privation of the Korean people, as well as the joy of being remembered by people in a free nation. He also related some of his experiences in assisting a group of University students in a two hour class of conversational English two days each week.
