All-Star Golf Gets One Hour

NBC-TV Network's "All-Star Golf" show has been expanded to a full-hour series and will be in Color. The 26-week series, with professional Jimmy Demaret as commentator, will be presented Saturdays from 5-6 p.m. PST, during the 1961-62 season, starting Oct. 14.

Reynolds Metals Company, through Lennen & Newell Inc., and Kemper Insurance Companies, through Clinton E. Frank Inc., have purchased sponsorship in the show.

Each week, "All-Star Golf" will feature two of the world's leading professional golfers as opponents in 18-hole medal play. The winner receives \$2,000 and returns the following week to oppose another challenger. The premiere show Oct. 14 pits Gary Player, this year's Masters titleholder, against Jerry Barber, recent winner of the Professional Golfers Association championship. The match was filmed at Sun City Golf Club near Phoenix, Arizona.

Nine matches in the Color series will be filmed at two eastern golf courses during the next two weeks.

Competing at the Concord International course at Kiamasha Lake, N.Y., Aug. 8-11 will be Arnold Palmer (1960 Nation Open and Masters Champion and recent winner of the British Open title), Peter Thompson, Tommy Bolt (former Open champion), Jackie Burke and Frank Stranahan.

Participating at the Pocono Manor (Pa.) golf course Aug. 14-18 will be all-time golf great Sam Snead, Player, Art Wall, Bob Goalby and Walt Durkemo.

Peter De Met is executive producer of the "All-Star Golf" series and Sidney Goltz is producer-director. Henry G. Saperstein is the packager of the show.

Repeat Fire Show

"Danger: Inflammable" featuring Jack Latham, KRCA's award winning newscaster, will be repeated, due to popular demand, tonight, August 13th on Channel 4, 5-5:30 p.m. (pre-empts "Dateline: U.N." series).

The special half-hour telecast is devoted to the extreme fire hazard facing Californian's this year, and what we can all do to help in this emergency. Film clips of recent fires are shown (including the Beachwood fire last May), plus vital information given on how to avoid fires and the precautions necessary.

Governor E. 'Pat' Brown of California; Chief Keith Klingler, Los Angeles County Fire Department; and Chief William Miller, Los Angeles City Fire Department, are all featured in special filmed interviews during the important telecast.

The help of all California residents — and visitors — is urged in the cooperation of preventing fires. 100% cooperation is needed from everyone as California faces the greatest fire period in the 20th Century. Last year was the driest weather year recorded since the weather bureau was formed in 1877.

Los Angeles County and City faces a particular hazard in the dreaded chaparral brush, which grows heavily in all hill areas. This highly inflammable brush places Los Angeles in constant danger of brush fires — more than anywhere else on earth!


