Torrance Company Notes Sales Hike

Sales of Union Carbide Corporation for the second quarter of 1961 were \$353,159,000, an increase of five per cent over sales of \$334,259,000 in the first quarter of this year. Earnings were up six per cent to \$35,671,000 or 0.119 per share, from the \$33,724,000, or \$1.12 a share, earned in this year's first quarter, according to Morse G. Dial, chairman and chief executive officer.

Sales in the second quarter of 1961 were two per cent better than the \$376,341,000 in the second quarter of 1960. Earnings, however, were nine per cent lower than the \$39,100,000, or \$1.30 per share, earned in the second quarter

of 1960. Thus, while the sales level reflects a pickup in the economy, earnings continue to experience the cost-price squeeze.

Sales for the first six months of the year amounted to \$747,458,000, three per cent below record sales of \$771,643,000 a year ago. Net income for the first half of 1961 amounted to 069,395,000, or \$2.31 per share, a decline of 15 per cent from \$81,192,000, or \$2.70 per share, for the comparable period in 1960.
