Lectures on Truth At Church of Christ

"What is Truth," will be the theme of a Christ-centered lecture series by Dr. J. P. Sanders, minister and college dean, Redondo Beach Church of Christ, 6122 Pacific Coast Hwy., Dr. Warren S. Jones, minister, announced today.

Beginning this Sunday and continuing thru Oct. 22, Dr. Sanders will be speaking each evening at 7:30 p.m. and each Sunday morning at 10:45 a.m.

Dr. Sanders, author, co-founder and former editor of the "20th Century Christian" magazine is dean of George Pepperdine College and professor of religion. He was dean of David Lipscomb College, Nashville, Tenn., for 14 years before moving to Southern California.

Commenting on the lecture series, Dr. Sanders said, "We will discuss in relation to the series theme, 'The Reality of God,' 'Can Opinion change Truth?,' 'Can There Be Conflict in Truth?,' and other pressing contemporary questions."

Among the topics for the lecture series Dr. Sanders has chosen, are "The Reality of God and Human Experience," "What Think ye of Christ," "The Cross — God's Revela-

tion of Truth," and "Christian Faith and Modern Knowledge."

Sanders will open the lecture series Sunday morning at the 10:45 a.m. worship service.


