

Porter of 2208 Cabrillo, Torrance, are serving with the First Marine Brigade, a unit of an amphibious task force scheduled to take part in Operation "Silver Sword" on Oct. 30, assaulting beaches on the Island of Maui in the largest maneuver of its kind to take place in the Hawaiian Islands since World War II.

A routine training exercise to improve proficiency and teamwork in amphibious techniques, the operation will consist of 25 ships, 100 Marine Corps aircraft and more than 10,000 sailors and marines. Climaxing several days intensive training in the area, the operation will begin when the first wave of the assault hits selected beaches on Maalea Bay shortly after midnight and is met by "opposing" forces to provide realistic combat training.

Joseph of 17210 Eastwood Ave., Torrance, is scheduled to complete four weeks individual combat training, Oct. 20, at the Second Infantry Training Regiment, Camp Pendleton. 
