A major replenishment at sea was also scheduled for the task force by fleet oilers, ammunition and stores ships.

More than 10,000 men and 150 ships, submarine and aircraft of the U.S. Navy, Royal Canadian Navy and Royal Canadian Air Force joined in the exercise, designed to strengthen combined U.S.-Canadian anti-submarine warfare capabilities and protect the large West Coast

cities of both nations from possible submarine attack.

George E. Turner, fireman, USN, son of Mr. and Mrs. Edwin A. Turner of 1409 W. 215th St., Torrance, while serving aboard the destroyer USS Taussig, participated in a large-scale Navy and Marine Corps training exercise observed by Admiral George W. Anderson, chief of naval operations, on Nov.

More than 40 Navy ships and aircraft, and elements of the First Marine Division and Third Marine Aircraft Wing took part in the operation, which featured anti-submarine warfare operations, missile firing, carrier operations and an amphibious assault.

The admiral observed the at-sea phase of the exercise

from the attack aircraft carrier USS Kitty Hawk and went ashore by helicopter to watch the amphibious landing in the Camp Pendleton area near Oceanside.

It was his first opportunity to see the Pacific Fleet in action since assuming the Navy's top post last August.






