Renaming Freeways Costs Taxpayer Money

A study of state freeway naming has been recommended by the board of directors of the California State Chamber of Commerce.

The action followed a recommendation of the chamber's Statewide Highway Committee, headed by F. W. Tarr, Chico, and was based on a detailed report prepared by the chamber's Subcommittee on Freeway Naming, headed by John McDonald of the Automobile Club of Southern California.

SINGLE NAMING
The chamber recommends the study be made by the State Department of Public Works, to include the establishment of criteria and procedures; the advisability of a single naming authority to eliminate confusion in freeway noa

freeway naming; and that an advisory committee be appointed by the legislature, consisting of representatives of cities and counties, motorists, business and industry, to assist the department in the study.

The committee's report revealed that lack of a single agency responsible for naming freeways has resulted in duplication of

names, changing of well-established names, adoption of unsuitable names, and the ensuing confusion of drivers trying to find their way about the freeway network.

COSTS \$98,000
The cost of changing freeway signs to comply with new names has become an important factor, for example, a recent proposal to change the name of a portion of the Harbor Freeway to San Pedro Freeway involved changing 129 state, 174 city, and approximately 50 county signs, at an estimated cost of over \$98,000.

Geographically significant freeway names considered appropriate and helpful to the driver are such names as the Coast Freeway, River Freeway or the presently used East Shore and Bay Shore freeways.
