

16,000 Students Train Yearly in VA Hospitals

The Veterans Administration has become the nation's largest training ground for colleges and universities in preparing students at the professional level for the medical field, Lowell C. Like, director of Los Angeles VA Center, announced recently.

More than 16,000 students spend part of their time at VA hospitals and clinics each year.

In return, affiliation with the schools brings faculty members and latest medical knowledge to VA stations and thus raises the quality of medical care for VA patients.

Participation in the medical education programs also helps the VA secure scarce highly trained personnel to fill its staff vacancies, Like said.

VA hospitals and clinics are affiliated with 75 of the nation's 85 medical schools, 32 of the 47 dental schools, all of the 56 accredited schools of social work, the 58 approved universities for graduate training in clinical and counseling psychology, about a tenth of the nation's nursing schools, and with 127 schools in providing clinical training in the physical medicine and rehabilitation therapies.

Beginning this fall, a new university-VA program, section of its kind in the nation, is training college graduates in rehabilitation of the blind.

Consider Use Of Helicopters In Transportation

The use of a "Jet age" fleet of passenger helicopters to complement the rapid transit system planned for the Los Angeles area is being investigated by the MTA, A. J. Eyraud, board chairman announced.

Eyraud said discussions are underway with President Clarence Belinn and other officials of Los Angeles Airways, Inc., to determine how passenger helicopter service can best be integrated into the entire public transit operation.

MTA and Los Angeles Airways officials will take a test ride on one of the new twin turbine helicopters Dec. 7 following a luncheon meeting at International Airport coordinated by MTA board member Don Belding.

"If we are to keep pace with the jet age," Eyraud said, "we must plan for a variety of commuter services which will meet all the public transit demands of the greatest metropolitan area in the nation."

"Helicopters offer the flexibility for extending travel free of traffic congestion to areas beyond the point where the rapid transit lines will terminate," he said.

Eyraud said MTA's engineering staff is completing a six-month report which will show the areas where helicopter service would be most beneficial in association with other transit operations.

medicine, neurology, neurosurgery, ophthalmology and orthopedic surgery.

Other fields: otolaryngology, pathology, physical medicine, plastic surgery, proctology, psychiatry, pulmonary diseases, radiology, thoracic surgery, and urology.

More than 7700 medical students serving clinical clerkships.

Thirty-nine dental residents in oral surgery, periodontia, and prosthodontia and 38 dental interns. These are relatively recent but increasingly important forms of advanced dental training.

Evergreens Grow Easily Anywhere

Planting evergreens is a deceptively easy job. No matter how you put them in the ground—unless it's upside down—they will usually grow.

Whether they actually thrive or not, however, is another point, and often a sore one with the inexperienced gardener.

We are reminded of this by a note from the California Association of Nurserymen. According to C.A.N., it's likely that eight out of 10 gardeners get less than they should from their newly planted evergreens.

The chances are equally one-sided that their problem lies in rushing through the planting process.

The great mistake and also the most common one in planting evergreens is not providing a suitable planting hole. You've heard the old warning against putting a five-dollar shrub into a two-bit hole.

Or have you? It's a good reminder to gardeners who would skimp on a little extra digging. If you dig the hole twice as wide as the root ball and half again as deep, you will be doing a good job.

Break up the soil in the bottom of the hole and add some loose topsoil up to the planting depth. Then fill in around the root ball with topsoil.

Depth of planting should approximate that of the soil in the nursery can. Your nurseryman might suggest sinking a specific shrub below the line at which it had been growing, but you'll seldom go wrong in bringing the new soil to the level that pertained in the nursery can.

Feeding is neither necessary nor desirable at planting time. Some well-rotted manure is all right when worked in below the root ball, but let the plant get well established before supplementing its food supply.

Watering is something else again. A basin should be made to permit flooding during the early life of the shrub. And not just close around the trunk, either. The basin should be formed out away from the trunk—out near the drip line—to insure that the entire root area will have access to plenty of water.

As with all the other steps, you can get by with a smaller basin, but you won't get the results.
