New Commander Will Take Over Area Marshal's Office

Los Angeles County Marshal Joe Bookman announced late last week a routine transfer of several division commanders which will affect the South Bay office.

Sgt. John Costello, who has been temporarily in command of this office, has been promoted to lieutenant and transferred to the West Los Angeles Division, and Lt. John W. Leamy, formerly commanding the Downey Marshal's office, will replace him.

Lt. Leamy has served with the Marshal's office for the past 10 years in various capacities and in many of the 28 branches the office maintains within the county, including prior service in the South Bay office. Forty-five years old, he was born in Springfield, Mass., came to Southern California in 1945. He currently resides at 810 North Maria St., Redondo Beach, with his wife, Jean, and their five children.

At present the South Bay office is staffed by four deputies and two clerks in addition to the commander. During the last fiscal year this office served 17,809 civil process, travelling 34,437 miles to accomplish these services, an average of only 3.61 miles per service.

They collected \$29,727.65 in earned fees (the fees for service of civil process are set by the state legislature) and actually returned to the county almost \$39 for each \$100 spent to maintain this branch.

In addition to the service of process, this division assigns bailiffs for each of the three Municipal Court divisions in the South Bay Judicial District.

Seek Annexation To Carson Area Light District

Residents on four streets in the Carson area may soon have street lights, County officials disclosed today.

A petition is currently being circulated to annex Nicolle Ave., Rashdall Ave., Kinard Ave. and 219th St. easterly of Moneta Ave. to Dolores Lighting District Zone 18.

Plans call for installation of 16 lights on these streets if the county Board of Supervisors approves the petition," they noted.

Thirteen of the lights will be installed on steel poles. Five will be put on Rashdall Ave., three apiece on Nicolle and Kinard Aves., and two on 219th St. The lights will all be installed by Southern California Edison Co.

Residents interested in the annexation should contact Mrs. Ralph L. Coolidge at 21834 Kinnard Ave., in Torrance.

Petition must be signed by property owners representing at least 60 per cent of the assessed valuation of all property on the four streets to receive board consideration.

Officials urged that the petition be returned to the board before Nov. 15, 1962, so lights can be installed as soon as possible after July 1, 1963.
