

Complete Work On Lomita Area Water Project

Water system distribution improvements within the Narbonne Ranch Water Company No. 2 Annex and the 240th St. Annex to County Waterworks District No. 13, Lomita, have been completed, it was disclosed this week by County Supervisor Burton W. Chace.

Construction work in the area northerly of Lomita Blvd. and westerly of Narbonne Ave. representing Phase IV of water system improvements was completed by the Card Construction Company under a \$48,488 contract. Simultaneously, work in 240th St. between Narbonne Ave. and Walnut Ave. was completed by Engineering Contractors, Inc., on \$21,500 contract.

PLUNGE INTO SMOKE




