Local Jehovah's Witnesses Plan District Meet

One of the 48 district conventions of Jehovah's Witnesses to be held in the United States this summer has been scheduled for the Orange County Fairgrounds, August 10 to 12.

Upwards of 7,500 delegates from congregations in the southern part of Los Angeles County and all of Orange and San Diego Counties will attend.

L. E. Olliff, presiding minister of the Torrance congregation, discussed plans for the coming event with his group.

He reported the developments of an organizational meeting held June 25 at the Costa Mesa convention headquarters, where 104 presiding ministers and key personnel were present. The meeting was for preliminary planning and coordinating of convention activities.

"Shield Halvajian, traveling representative of the Watchtower Society, who has been named as convention manager, presided at the meeting.

"Each of 20 department heads appointed by the New York headquarters, gave a brief report on organizational planning. These 20 departments will provide for all convention needs including an orchestra, a complete cafeteria and first aid department.

"All work will be done by Jehovah's Witnesses themselves on a voluntary basis using their spare time and vacations," Olliff explained.

He stated that many associated with his congregation had volunteered to work in the various departments as assigned according to individual skill and experience.
