

Bible Contest Winner Visits, Speaks in Area

Bruce Barton once wrote that Bible is "the book nobody knows."

He never met Senora Yolanda Da Silva.

Mrs. Da Silva, a soft-spoken housewife and teacher from Sao Paulo, Brazil, is in Southern California this week visiting friends and speaking in Los Angeles area Adventist churches before going to San Francisco where she will be a delegate to the 49th world conference of Seventh-day Adventists convening July 26.

No question about it, Mrs. Da Silva knows her Bible. In 1960 she entered a Brazil-wide contest that country was holding to determine who knew most about the sacred Scriptures. To the amazement of most officials of the contest she won with apparent ease.

Last year she entered the

Brazilian contest again. And although there were 500 contestants vying for top honors Mrs. Da Silva again won the event.

Having won the Brazilian contest she was sent by that country to Jerusalem in September, 1961, to compete in the Second International Bible Contest conducted by the Israel Broadcasting Corporation.

"Needless to say," says Mrs. Da Silva in her native Portuguese, "I felt quite apprehensive about this world contest. There were professional Bible students, ministers, priests and rabbis in the international event."

18 COUNTRIES
Representatives of 18 countries gathered in Jerusalem's National Palace auditorium for the contest. Israeli President Ben-Zvi and Prime Minister Ben-Gurion were present as was an imposing board of examiners headed by the chief justice of the Supreme Court of Israel.

"The contest began at 8 o'clock in the evening," Mrs. Da Silva states. "By two o'clock the next morning only the representatives of New Zealand, Israel, South Africa and the United States besides myself were still in the running."

"Then the South African representative, a fellow Seventh-day Adventist, was eliminated as the result of an error in translation from Afrikaans into Israeli through two translators.


