

Freeway Expense Stressed By Official; \$104 Million

Supervisor Kenneth Hahn recently cited the nearly-completed Harbor freeway as an example of the huge expense of money—and time—needed to bring transportation facilities to Los Angeles County.

"When the final link between 208th street and Pacific Coast Highway is opened in mid-August," Hahn observed, "the completed 23-mile freeway will represent \$104 million and 15 years of work."

He compared the cost of the Harbor freeway with the Metropolitan Transit Authority's proposed underground pilot mass rapid transit system, which also faces right-of-way headaches and cumbersome construction.

FIND ROADWAY

"The Harbor freeway is a fine roadway—a real asset to the motorist of this area," the supervisor said.

"But, like all heavy construction projects, it took a long time and a lot of money to build."

Hahn recalled that the Harbor freeway was given "top priority" when he was a member of the Los Angeles City Council in 1947.

When construction began on the freeway, other City Councilmen, serving with Mayor Fletcher Brown, were Leland S. Warburton, Lloyd G. Davies, J. Win Austin, Harold A. Henry, George P. Cronk, L. E.
