Chairman Explains Function Of Cancer Society's Office

"The American Cancer Society District Office helps Torrance residents solve the many problems that arise when cancer strikes.

"The steady growth of the Society's local service program has made it increasingly easier to help cancer patients overcome some of the difficulties that arise as a result of their illness," Mrs. P. B. Marsh, a member of the Order of Eastern Star and District Volunteer Service and chairman for the American Cancer Society, reported today.

"Our district office 804 E. Manchester Blvd., Inglewood, is set up to help those who are faced with cancer problems—to talk with the cancer patient or his family; to find out the needs of a particular case; to determine the best available source of help," she said.

"For the patient this is one of the most valuable functions of the society's service program," Mrs. Marsh stated. "Other services that are available are supplies needed to care for the patient in the home such as sick room equipment and surgical dressings." Mrs. Marsh explained that although free dressings have been offered for some years, many cancer patients and their families are still unaware that they are available at the office of the society.

"For the past few years," she said, "the Society has been working with various Chapters of the Order of Eastern Star; Ladies Auxiliary of the Fleet Reserve Association, No. 39; Inglewood Opti-Mrs.; Ladies Circle of the Inglewood First Lutheran Church; Health and Welfare Section of the Inglewood Woman's Club; Hawthorne and Westchester Senior Citizens; Hawthorne's

Beta Eta Chapter; Epsilon Sigma Alpha Sorority; Westchester Loyola Village Women's Club; and Manhattan Beach Neptunian Club to develop this dressing program and we are very proud it is functioning so well."


