### Symphony to Present First Concert of Autumn Season

The Beach Cities Symphony, directed by Composer-Conductor Louis Palange, will appear in the first concert of the thirteenth season on Friday at 8:15 p.m. at Mira Costa High School auditorium in Manhattan Beach.


Included in the program will be Rhenzi Overture by Richard Wagner, Norwegian Rhapsody No. 3 by Svendsen; Finlandia by Sibelius and Concerto for Cello and Orchestra by Haydn. Featured as soloist will be Peter Snyder, who was born in Brooklyn, New York, 18 years ago, began his musical career at the age of three, when his mother, a concert pianist and organist, began teaching him.

**MUSIC PROGRAM**  
His family moved to Los Angeles in 1947, where he grew up and graduated from high school under a special education program sponsored by the Los Angeles Conservatory of Music and Art. He is a sophomore in college under the same scholarship plan. He began studying the cello at the age of seven and shortly after-

ward received a scholarship to study with Cesare Pascarella of the world famous Roth Quartette.

**CONCERT CAREER**  
It was with the advice of Gregor Piatagorsky that he decided to continue his study of the cello in preparation for a concert career. Snyder has appeared as soloist with many Southern California symphony orchestras, as well as winning a recital under a program called "Musicians in the Making."

He was accepted for the Tchaikovsky competition in Moscow this past spring but was unable to attend. He is planning to attend the Pablo-Casals competition in Budapest, Hungary, in 1963.
