



Editor of 'Punch' To Speak at ECC

Malcolm Muggeridge, noted journalist and former editor-in-chief of the British humor magazine Punch, will address an audience of students, faculty and local citizens in the Campus Theater of El Camino College, Wednesday, Oct. 31 at 8:30 p.m.

Acclaimed for his critical book, "A Winter in Moscow," the English born Muggeridge attended Cambridge University where he took an honors degree at the age of twenty, taught in the Egyptian University in Cairo, served as a Moscow correspondent for the Manchester Guardian, and has appeared on numerous British, Australian and American television programs, including several appearances on the Jack Paar show.

Since his resignation in 1957 as editor-in-chief of Punch, where he was the first editor the magazine had ever employed from outside its own staff, Muggeridge has been writing for the Sunday Pictorial and the New Statesman and Nation, and traveled to the USSR
