

Harbor General Hospital Sets Dedication Program

The new Harbor General Hospital soon will open its doors at Carson St. and Vermont Ave. in Torrance, Supervisor Kenneth Hahn said today.

Official dedication ceremonies have been set for 10 a.m. Jan. 14 with Supervisor Burton W. Chace and Hahn planning the event.

William Barr, superintendent of the County Department of Charities, will be principal speaker. The public is invited to join more than 500 civic dignitaries at the event.

The new facility will provide a total capacity of 605 beds and 74 bassinets in the central, eight-story unit of the three-structure complex, Hahn noted.

"Harbor Hospital will be one of the most modern of its kind in California," he said.

Features of the hospital include an outpatient clinic capable of handling 9000 patient visitations per month, a laboratory and general facilities located on lower floors as a convenience to patients and visitors. Offices having the least to do with serving patients—payroll, accounting, administration, and the like—will be located on upper floors of the hospital.

Citizens voted a \$15 million bond issue in 1956 to build the new hospital to replace the substandard "temporary" structures purchased in 1947 from the U.S. Army.


