'All My Sons' Proves a Hit At Footlight

Footlight Theater continues the drama "All My Sons" for two more weekends — Feb. 8 and 9, and 15 and 16, at 3331 Torrance Blvd.

Opening night proved a hit. Each player fits his role so naturally, it is hard to realize the members of the cast are acting. As one first-nighter said, "It's just like eavesdropping."

Though "All My Sons" is drama, comedy lightens the tension, and one leaves with pleasant memories of the Kellers and their neighbors. It is directed by Herman Goodman.

Dr. and Mrs. Bayliss, one set of neighbors, are played by Dale Love and Phyllis Foss, superb in the role of a gay and witty wife, who chides her doctor-husband for his attention to his female patients.

The other neighbors — the Lubeys — come through pleasantly and cheerfully.

Lydia Luby, played by Connie Hauser, always seems to be having trouble with her electrical appliances, which hubby Frank Luby, played by Jim O'Donnell, manages to fix.

Frank Luby's "Mr. Fix-it" abilities are unable to heal the mental strain of Kate Keller, played by Evelyn Jones, who will not believe that her son is dead, or the anguish of Joe Keller, played by Louis Verne, caused by a hidden guilt he feels allowing his partner (Deever) take the blame for defective parts made by their partnership firm.

Deever's son is played by Bud Greene and his return is a tense, dramatic moment in the play. His bitterness and his concern for the welfare of his sister weigh heavily on him.

Glenn Hoeffner, as always, portrays with amazing realism the character of Chris Keller, the tormented son of Joe Keller.

Lanna Hicks as Ann, Chris' girl friend, is excellent.

Those not seen but whose work is displayed throughout the performance deserve to be mentioned. The beautiful moonlight effects on the lovely green lawn and the special lighting throughout is done by Jean O'Donnell. Prop girl is Linda Kraegel.
