Curbs Go 'Red' At Intersections

To provide greater visibility at intersections for both pedestrians and motorists, a new curb painting program is under way in the second supervisory district represented by Kenneth Hahn.

"This is a simple and inexpensive program," Hahn observed, "but oftentimes such a basic step can do much to improve traffic safety."

At Hahn's request, the curbs at all intersections in unincorporated areas will be painted red for a distance of 10 to 15 feet from the corner.

"This will insure unobstructed vision around corners and reduce the number of accidents," Hahn said.

The curb painting commenced early this month and soon will be carried out in all unincorporated areas.
