


Love That Salad



Fruit Salad Earns Praise

FAMOUS FRUIT SALAD DRESSING

- 1/3 cup sugar
 - 1 teaspoon flour
 - 1 egg yolk
 - 1/2 cup canned pineapple juice
 - 2 tablespoons canned lemon juice
 - 1 teaspoon celery seed
 - 1 cup whipping cream
- Mix sugar, flour and egg yolk in a saucepan. Add fruit juices and cook over low heat until thickened, stirring constantly. Add celery seed. Cool. Stir in whipped cream just before serving. Makes about two cups.

Cranberry Bran Muffins Find Favor at Brunch

Entering at brunch is easy—it can be informal and calls for rather simple dishes. Some Spring weekend, try this brunch menu: Broiled Grapefruit, Creamed Chipped Beef with Sliced Hard-Cooked Eggs, Cranberry Bran Muffins, and plenty of good Hot Coffee. CRANBERRY BRAN MUFFINS

- 3/4 cup sifted flour
- 2 1/2 teaspoons double-acting baking powder
- 1/4 teaspoon salt

- 1/4 cup sugar
 - 1 egg, well beaten
 - 3/4 cup milk*
 - 3 tablespoons shortening, melted
 - 1 1/2 cups 40% bran flakes
 - 1/2 cup chopped uncooked cranberries
- *Sour milk may be substituted for sweet milk; add 1/2 teaspoon soda and decrease baking powder to 2 teaspoons.
- Measure sifted flour, add baking powder, salt, and sugar, and sift together. Combine egg and milk. Add to flour mixture, add shortening, and then mix only enough to dampen flour. Fold in cereal and cranberries. Spoon into greased muffin pans, filling each two-thirds full. Bake in hot oven (425 deg. F.) 15 to 20 minutes. Makes 8 medium-sized muffins.

Deviled Ham and Apple Flavor Stuffed Pancakes

Try spicily stuffed pancakes for a very special brunch or supper. They're "just the thing" for Spring servings — satisfying and savory with lively flavored deviled ham and juicy, crisp apple. In fact, deviled ham lends itself, zestily, to any number of pancakes recipes. Try it, for instance, spread between layers of pancakes, stacked and served with sour cream, maple syrup and a glorious hot orange sauce!

SPICILY STUFFED PANCAKES

- 1 cup pancake mix

- 1 cup milk
 - 1 tablespoon liquid shortening
 - 1 egg
 - 1 cup sliced apples
 - 1 1/2 ounce can deviled ham
- Make pancakes according to directions on package. Fold in apples. Use a generous quarter cup of the batter for pancake. Remove from griddle and spread with deviled ham. Roll and place on heated platter. Serve with a dollop of sour cream.
