





## School Offers Courses For Kiddies, First Aid

Openings exist for the fourth quarter registration of mothers with pre-school-aged children at the McMaster Park Child Observation class held each Tuesday, according to Ray E. Collins, principal of Torrance Adult Education program. Classes meet in the Recreation Building at McMaster Park, at Artesia Blvd. and Yukon Ave.

Children aged two and one-half to five enjoy morning of supervised outdoor play, snack, rest, group participation in games, creative play at clay, finger paints, puzzles, etc., while the mothers learn techniques of handling groups of children. The Parent Education hour for mothers this quarter will feature discussion on "Children We Can Enjoy and Be Proud Of," dealing with the mother's influence over children's reactions and adjustment to our complex society.

Registration will be held Tuesday morning, April 16, at the Park, from 9 a.m. until 12 noon. Mrs. Randall is in charge.

The Torrance Adult Education office has announced that there are a limited number of openings available in the Pre-Kindergarten Class at Waleria Park which meets each Wednesday afternoon in the Recreation Building, from 12:30 to 3:30 p.m.

Parents having children who will be entering kindergarten in September may register at the park Wednesday, April 17, from 12:30 and 3:30 p.m., on a "first come first served" basis. Mrs. Fritz Greenspan has charge of registration and instruction.

Special emphasis is being placed on preparation of the child for kindergarten. Mothers observe children with others of their own age at play, or working with creative materials such as clay, finger painting and games. The program is geared to the four and five year old.

Field trips are included to give the mothers and children a chance for original learning experiences. Opportunities are allowed for the children to express themselves, and for mothers to discuss common problems and hear outside resource speakers from the field of child growth and development.

Mrs. Greenspan also has limited openings in the morning group for children 2½ years to kindergarten age, which meets Wednesday mornings at Waleria Park from 9 to 12 a.m. Registration will be taken Wednesday morning, April 17, from 9 and 12, on a first come first served basis.
