Street Lighting Sought By Those In 'Dark'

A petition for street lights was filed on April 1 with the City of Torrance by 175 residents in the area bounded by W. 177th, Arlington, W. 182nd and Crenshaw Blvd.

Bob Errickson, who circulated the petition, said the signatures are being checked by the City of Torrance. He said signatures were obtained from 61 to 85 percent of the residents on the

streets involved. The Department of Traffic and Lighting told Errickson that as soon as the signatures are checked, a lighting district will be designed. About June or July when public-hearing notices are posted on the streets, residents may check the location of light standards at the office of J. C. Whitmer, traffic and lighting engineer, City Hall.

Installation of the lights will begin about November 1, and should be completed by January, according to Errickson.
