

War Hero Of Israel To Appear

A hero of Israel's War of Independence and pioneer of his country's air force will visit Los Angeles Sunday, April 28, as guest of the Israel Bond organization, according to Sam Levy, Torrance chairman of the 15th Anniversary Israel Festival of the South Bay Area. Col. Gideon Elrom will be guest of honor at the gala Israel Independence Eve event, scheduled for 8 p.m. at the Temple Menorah Social Hall. One of the key figures in the revision and modernization of the Israel Air Force, Colonel Elrom was until recently Deputy Commander-in-Chief of the Air Force. Previously he had served as Director of Training and Intelligence of Israel's Fighter Bomber Wing. He played a major role in planning Israel's air operations during the Sinai Campaign in 1956.
