Competing for top spot among the nation's B fuelers will be the Forsberg and Hubbard dragster from San Francisco and Tom McCourry of San Fernando. The winner will race against the gas eliminator finalist later in the evening for the gas eliminator title. In the gas eliminator event, contestants include the country's No. 1 gas dragster driver, John Peters of Santa Monica; No. 2 driver, George Bolthoff of Burbank; Zane Shubert of Santa Ana; Ron Hier of Venice; Bob Noice in the Accessories Ltd. dragster; Dick Bell of Compton and others. Another feature race this Saturday night is the regular fuel elimination, in which Tom Ewen of Long Beach is favored to win. Other fuel dragster drivers on the program are Don Moody of Santa Monica, former world record holder; Jack Ewell of Torrance; Hank Clark of Bakersfield; Jeep Hampshire of San Fernando and Frank Cannon of Compton.
