

40th Division's Charity Project

Veteran 40th Armored Division officers and men were informed this week that their presence in Korea 11 years ago resulted in more than the vital defense of a strife-split country.

The division learned that ground was broken early this month in Seoul for the Korean Amputee Rehabilitation Center, made possible by contributions from thousands of men of the California National Guard unit.

The 40th was one of several military units contributing a total of \$40,000 toward the Amputee Center during combat service in Korea.

When completed, the 28-room center will accommodate up to 60 patients, providing prosthetics for amputees and training in their use.

Components of the division are located in almost every city from the Mexican border to Tulare, including Torrance.

South High to Enrich Summer

Enrichment and broadening of educational horizons for students is the aim of South High School's summer school programs this year according to Dr. John A. Lucas, principal.

Although classes for grade improvement and make-up will be offered, students are urged to enroll in one of the 25 enrichment classes, some of which are not offered during the regular school year. Students who otherwise could not fit in these classes in a regular schedule now have an opportunity to benefit from them.

Summer school starts June 24 and ends August 2. There will be two 2-hour classes everyday, 8 a.m. to 10 a.m. and 10 a.m. to 12 noon.
