

'The Showoff' Scheduled by Student Group

The major spring production of the Harbor College Drama Department, "The Show-Off" by George Kelly, is being staged in the Starboard Theater May 9-16. This production will be one of the many activities of the Fine Arts Festival which will be going on at the Wilmington campus at the same time. "The Show-Off," a domestic comedy of middle class

life set in the 1920's will be a change of pace for many of the actors and director Reuben Plaskoff. Recent productions such as "Medea," "Waltz of the Toreadors," and "Oedipus Rex" have been of a serious and experimental nature contrasting greatly with the light but meaningful humor of the present production. The part of Aubrey Piper, who is the "show-off" will

be played by Eugene Dynarski, veteran of many Harbor dramatic productions. This also will be Dynarski's final appearance in a local production as he is scheduled to work in summer stock and then enter UCLA. Esther Drake plays the part of Mrs. Fisher, a voluble and emotional critic of Piper. Although this is her first Harbor College appearance, Mrs. Drake has been

active for ten years in other dramatic groups such as the Chapel Players, Magnolia Theater, Community Playhouse and the Hampton Players. Aubrey's wife, Amy, is played by Virginia Preston. 
