### Summer Swim Program Set at El Camino College

June 15 will initiate the annual summer instructional swimming program at El Camino College, with registration for the first three sessions being taken on that day.

Five two-week sessions will be offered local residents under the supervision of college physical education instructors and student recreation leaders. Cost for each two-week period of instruction is \$1 per person.

Starting at 8 a.m., registration will be conducted in the Campus Center.

Sessions will extend from June 17 to 28, July 1 to 12, July 15-26, July 29 to Aug. 9 and Aug. 12 to 23. Enrollment for the latter two periods will be held in the Campus Center at 8 a.m. July 27, John W. Morrow, assistant director of instruction in the field of physical edu-

cation, announced. If tickets for instructional periods are available following registration on July 15 and 27, they will be placed on sale in the college business office.

Minimum age for instruction is seven years; minimum height requirement is 50 inches. All swimmers must furnish bathing suits and towels, and girls must wear bathing caps, Morrow specified.

Classes will be offered by age groups from 8 a.m. through 9 p.m. Schedules designating specific hours of instruction for each group are now available in the college registration office and the physical education department.

Included in the summer program are swimming sessions for adults, for junior and senior life saving instruction and instruction in water safety aids.

"Children must be present when registration tickets are purchased," Morrow emphasized.

Additional to the aquatic program this summer, recreational facilities will be open to both children and adults in day and evening programs conducted throughout the week. Schedules for these activities are also available on the college campus.

Included in the adult program will be such recreational activities as badminton, tennis, volleyball, basketball, gymnastics, tumbling and trampoline.
