Opening dates and summer schedules of local playground and school pools operated by the County of Los Angeles Department of Parks and Recreation were announced this week by Supervisor Kenneth Hahn.

Free swimming will be offered to all boys and girls under 18 years of age, Saturdays between 10 a.m. and 12 noon. Pools opening on or before June 8 will be operated weekends and will not begin their daily schedules until June 15, when all county pools officially open, with exception of areas where school semesters end June 21).

Competitive swim programs leading up to the All-County Championships at the end of the summer, Junior Frogman classes, and Learn to Swim instruction will be offered at all pools, weekdays from 9:30-12 noon.

Admission to county pools is 15 cents for youngsters under 12, 25 cents for teenagers 17 years and under, and 50 cents for adults.

Forrest White of 550 Torrance Blvd. has been selected to attend an eight-week mathematics institute this summer at Oregon State University. He teaches at West High School.

The institute will be supported by a grant from the National Science Foundation. Fifty-six juniors and
