

San Diego Freeway Last Link Dedicated; It's Open Now!

Dedication of the last link of the San Diego Freeway separating the San Fernando Valley and the Long Beach Freeway last week was the highlight of a week-long Southern California observance of National Highway Week.

Dedication of the 5.7 mile segment of the San Diego Freeway between El Segundo Blvd. and Jefferson Blvd. in the City of Centurywood was held on the Century Blvd. bridge at 11 a.m. In attendance were civic leaders from the cities along the entire San Diego Freeway route from the San Fernan-

do Valley south. After the dedication, officials did attend a luncheon at the Airport Marina Hotel.

Open This Week
Cost of the project, which was opened to traffic this week and will provide 41 miles of continuous freeway between the San Fernando Valley and the Long Beach Freeway, was \$16.5 million.

Sea Barrier Recharge Wells Bids Opened; \$300,000 Job

Bids to construct 12 recharge wells as part of the project to halt sea water intrusion along the west coast were opened Friday in offices of Flood Control District Chief Engineer M. E. Salsbury at 11 a.m. Estimates place cost of the work at \$300,000.

line now under construction to help maintain a barrier against further brine intrusion into fresh water supplies.

District engineers will study all bids and recommend final award of contract to the Board of Supervisors in about 10 days, Supervisor Chace announced.

The wells will be installed along Prospect Avenue between Spencer Street and Torrance Boulevard in Redondo Beach, the Supervisor reported.

Designated Unit 1A of the West Coast Basin Barrier Project, the 12 recharge wells will utilize water from a 5.9-mile water supply pipe-

Work is slated to begin within three weeks after formal award of contract and is due for completion in about seven months.

SABIN CLINIC THURSDAY

Type III oral Sabin polio clinic is scheduled for Thursday from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. at the Torrance Health Center, 2300 W. Carson St., announced Dr. E. W. Kendrick, district health officer for the Los Angeles County Health Department.

with Salk vaccine can get a booster effect for all three types by taking the oral polio vaccine, but only if all three types are taken.

A donation of 25 cents will be asked to cover costs. Free vaccine will be available for those unable to pay.

Sabin vaccine has the advantage over other polio protection in that it has a longer lasting immunity and prevents the immunized person from being an "asymptomatic carrier." There are no current recommendations for booster doses of Sabin vaccines.

Although sugar cubes will be used to dispense the vaccine, sugar-free vaccine will be available to infants and to others on request.

Dr. Kendrick reminds parents of school age children students will need to show proof of polio immunization before they can enter school in the fall. A State health and safety law now requires most students to be immunized against polio. Persons getting polio protection at the County Health Department clinics will get immunization certificates which can be used for school admission.

Procedure Told
The immunization procedure for the oral or Sabin vaccine consist of the administration of type I, type II and type III polio virus vaccines, administered separately. A separate vaccine is made against each of the three polio viruses. Each dose, therefore, provides protection only against the type of virus it contains. All three types of oral Sabin vaccine are needed to complete immunization.


Most Severe Cases
Adults of all ages are also urged to get vaccinated against polio. Although only two per cent of all paralytic cases occur in those 40 years of age and over, these are usually among the most severe. It is particularly important for parents of young children and pregnant women to get polio protection.

Oral vaccine can be taken by persons who have already had the Salk polio vaccine. Anyone who has been properly vaccinated
