Officials of the Torrance Family YMCA today added a new session of summer camp to the full schedule slated during the school vacation period.

Since all of the younger girls' camps were full, the YMCA has secured Camp Mozumdar near Crestline for an eight-day session from July 13-20.

Camp Mozumdar will be limited to girls between the ages of nine and 13. In recent years this beautiful camp site has not been used because local YMCA groups have outgrown the size limitations of the camp. Now, with an overflow group of 50 younger girls who signed up too late for Camp Big Pines, this favorite spot will be utilized for fun and adventure for those who sign up late.

In addition to a lovely lodge and dining hall, the camp boasts a heated swimming pool, archery and handicraft centers, mountain trails, outdoor chapel, horseback riding and a campfire circle for evening enjoyment.

Other Torrance YMCA

camps are filling rapidly, with the next scheduled groups to depart on July 13 in four different camp sessions.

Boys 12 and up will travel to Toulumne Base camp in the High Sierras; boys 14 and up will tackle the John Muir Trail over Vogelsang Pass into Losmitte Valley; girls 9 to 13 will visit the newly created Mozumdar session; and, more than 30 families will spend the week with the YMCA at the popular Yosemite Valley camp.

At the present time, a number of older boys are exploring the Glen Canyon area of the Colorado River in outboard boats.


