\$5,500 STREET JOB SLATED

The board of supervisors has authorized a \$5,500 improvement of a portion of 220th Street in the Carson-Dominguez area, Supervisor Burton W. Chace said today.

Included in the project will be extending pavement to join with new curb and gutter installations on 220th from 300 feet west of Wilmington Avenue to 720 feet westerly of Martin Street.

In addition, a portion of existing pavement will be resurfaced, improving drainage and operational efficiency of the road, Chace said.



\$900,000 SLATED FOR MAJOR STREET JOBS

Nearly \$900,000 for major street and highway improvements is earmarked for projects in the Lomita-Dominguez areas in the 1963-64 county road department budget.

Supervisor Burton W. Chace said the \$42.7 million appropriation for major county street work will include \$560,000 for a Sepulveda Boulevard program.

This work, Chace said, will include land acquisition and construction of a six-lane highway from Western Avenue to Vermont Avenue. Other road projects include:

Lomita Boulevard—Normandie Avenue to Main Street, \$173,000.

223rd Street — Normandie to Alameda Street, \$131,000.

Sepulveda Boulevard, Main Street to Avalon Boulevard, \$20,000.

"These are but a few of the county's highway projects designed to reduce the street deficiency program of the road department," Chace said.
