Wide Variety of Activities on Tap in Recreation Dept.

Children are not the only people with "time on their hands."

While the Torrance recreation department moves into high gear during the summer months to provide a full span of activities for the community's vacationing youth, its many programs for adults also continue to offer variety and enjoyment in the recreation use of leisure time.

Sponsor Theatre Bus Trips

The Torrance Adult Club is sponsoring its popular theatre bus trips, including summer tours to the Laguna Festival of Arts on Aug. 4; the Greek Theater, featuring Harry Bellafonte, on Aug. 22; and Dodger Stadium, on Aug. 23, for the Dodger-Milwaukee game. A trip to the Hollywood Bowl on July 6 for the Royal Ballet of London performance was enjoyed by many adults.

Music, Special Events

Other activities of an entertaining nature are scheduled in a series of Sunday programs at the Torrance Park bandshell and in other special events at the Recreation Center. On Aug. 9 and 10 the department will feature its annual carnival and aquacade at the Benstead Plunge.

Some of the most enthusiastically supported adult programs are those involving physical recreation activities offered in swimming, golf, tennis, softball, and bowling.

Men's, Women's Softball

Hundreds of men in the community participate in the many softball and slip-pitch leagues which meet on week nights at four of the Torrance parks — Walteria, El Nido, Torrance, and McMaster. Women's softball teams have formed a league with games scheduled at El Nido and McMaster Parks on Tuesday and Thursday nights. Housewives' softball, co-sponsored by the Torrance and the county parks and recreation departments, meets on Tuesday mornings at McMaster Park.

Golf Popular Program

Golf activities comprise another outstanding adult program. At the Sea-Aire Golf Course, adult instruction is offered on week-day evenings in several three-week summer sessions.

The Sea-Aire Women's Golf Club meets Thursdays, 9 a.m. until noon, with periodic tournaments and other

er special events scheduled. The Sea-Aire course, a 9 hole, par 3 course, is also open for public use every day except Monday, at 50 cents a round.

Swimming, Tennis, Bowling Swimming instruction for adults is available at the city's Benstead Plunge. Classes for beginner, intermediate, and swimmer levels are offered on Tuesdays and Thursday evenings. The plunge is open every day for recreational swimming, with Thursday nights as Family Nights, and Fridays, 7 to 8 p.m., for adults only. Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, and at West High School on Tuesdays and Thursdays, special evening classes in tennis instruction are available to adults.

Housewives participate in their own bowling league on Tuesday mornings at the Bowl-O-Drome. While teams are filled, substitutes are still needed and may register by calling the recreation department.

Senior Citizen Groups

Formed especially for adults over 55 years of age, Senior Citizens Clubs are active at El Retiro, McMaster and Walteria Parks and the Torrance Adult Center. The various clubs offer many types of activities, some of them including shuffleboard games and tournaments, card games, parties, and pleasure trips, movies and lectures.

COLLEGE TELLS SCHEDULE FOR EXAMS

Entrance examinations required of all new students at Los Angeles Harbor College will be given throughout the summer, according to William H. McMasters, Assistant Dean of Admissions and Guidance. 


