

## 'Walk on the Wet Side,' Surfing Film Scheduled

Dale Davis will narrate his all-color surf film, "Walk on the Wet Side" this Friday and Saturday evenings at Pier Avenue Auditorium, Hermosa Beach. According to county lifeguards, who premiered his film in Santa Monica, Davis brings a fresh approach to surfing films and presents Southern California surfing in a distinctive style.

"Walk on the Wet Side" features world champion Midget Farrelly in action at Rincon Beach. Davis filmed the Aussie during Farrelly's brief visit to Southern California. Southland surfing stars featured are Johnny Sain, Dewey Weber, Bob

Cooper, Mike Doyle and Phil Edwards are featured riding surf at Hammonds Reef, Oil Piers, Haggertys, Indicator, Ventura power plant and the Sand Spits.

"Walk on the Wet Side" features a new and secret surfing spot, mysteriously named the gas chamber.

The Los Angeles County Lifeguard Assn. is sponsoring Davis's film. Proceeds go to the association fund for youth and welfare activities including the junior lifeguard program. This Friday and Saturday will be the only South Bay showing of "Walk on the Wet Side." Show time is 8:45 p.m. Admission is \$1.25.

## Lecturer to Tell Adventures In His 18-Year African Stay

Jean-Pierre Hallet, internationally famous for his humanitarian work among 650,000 natives of primitive Africa, will give a lecture entitled "Cannibalism and Human Sacrifices."

Hallet is the only western man who lived 18 years among the natives of Africa totally isolated from civilization. He survived 18 months alone with the Ituri Forest Bambuti Pygmies, the most primitive, unknown, and restive people in the world.

He was initiated blood-brother with the Masai, Bantande, and Balega, fulfilling all the required tribal rituals, resolutely prevented the death of hundreds of natives from famine and ritual human sacrifice, accepted the challenge to fight a full grown lion to death, armed only with a crude native spear and thereby amply proving his traditional warrior status.

Hallet is steeped in witchcraft, black magic, secret societies and their rituals through his comprehensive mastery of six aboriginal languages and 17 dialects.

He succeeded in compiling the world's largest private collection of unusual primitive African artifacts.

Without whip or gun, he tamed 65 wild animals, using his own humane technique of mutual confidence, and a unique method of "big-cat" hypno-mesmerism.

Hallet's lecture is Friday evening at 8 p.m. at the Woman's Club of San Pedro, 1041 S. Gaffey, San Pedro. It is sponsored by American People for Better Understanding of Africa, and chairman is John O'Reilly of Torrance. Donation is \$1, and the public is invited. 
