**Harry James to Open at Disneyland**

Harry James, his trumpet and his sensational new Swingin' Band will open a six-night engagement at Disneyland beginning Aug. 27. The internationally famous band leader brings with him star drummer Buddy Rich and an array of musical greats which have made the James band a favorite for many years. As a part of the Nighttime Magic of Disneyland, the James aggregation is the latest in a summer-long parade of the greatest names in music.

The top-ranking group will play for listening and dancing in Tomorrowland from 8 p.m. to midnight on Aug. 27, 28 and 29 and from 9 p.m. to 1 a.m. on Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights, Aug. 30 through the eve of Labor Day, Sept. 1. Regular Disneyland prices will be in effect with no extra admission charge for the Harry James concerts. In addition, Disneyland's Nighttime Magic includes music by the Elliott Brothers, the Ward Singers, the Firehouse Five Plus Two,

the Young Men From New Orleans and the Spacemen with Gay Bell plus every night at nine o'clock "Fantasy in the Sky" with Tinkerbelle and a mammoth fireworks display.

**Belafonte Draws Big Crowds to Greek: Closes Sept. 7**

Belafonte and Company continue to draw nightly capacity crowds to the Greek Theater in Los Angeles. The engagement, scheduled through Saturday, Sept. 7, will be interrupted on the evening of Wednesday, Aug. 28 when no performance will be given; however, the popular artist has added another date, Sunday, Sept. 1. Patrons already holding tickets for the cancelled date can exchange them for any other night available.

This most successful of all seasons will conclude with the week of Sept. 9 when the brightest of the young folk musicians, the Kingston Trio, take to the amphitheater stage for the first time. Since 1958 when three college lads took the country by musical storm with a styling fresh, sensitive and down-to-earth, the trio has played most top night clubs

in the country, packed the auditoriums of virtually every major college and university, ranks among the top record sellers of all time and has literally set America to singing the music of its own heritage. Henry Mancini, one of the outstanding musical names in audio-visual media, joins the Kingston Trio as music director and will preside over the Greek Theater orchestra. A program of musical favorites associated with Mancini and with the trio is being especially put together and promises to bring this 11th annual season to a close on a high and happy note.

Tickets are available for some performances of the Belafonte Show and for all evenings of the final attraction. Sunday evening, Sept. 15 will be the final performance of this record-breaking summer.
