

HOUSEWIVES' SWIM CLASSES RESCHEDULED FOR SEPTEMBER

Housewives' swim classes, sponsored by the Torrance recreation department, have been rescheduled to begin Sept. 16, it was announced today. Life-saving classes for housewives have been postponed until Sept. 30.

Classes will be held on Mondays-Wednesdays-Fridays in the following sessions: Sept. 16 to 27; Sept. 30 to Oct. 11; and October 14 to 25.

Class hours for intermediates and swimmers will begin at 9:30 a.m.; for intermediates and advanced beginners at 10:30 a.m.; and for beginners at 11:30 a.m.

The senior life-saving class will run from Sept. 30 to Oct. 25.

There will be a pool service charge of \$1.75 for each six-lesson series.

Parents and students are reminded that a new state law requires all students to furnish the school with evidence of polio immunization before completing registration.

During the first few days of school, students will receive information regarding the pupil protection insurance plan. This plan provides accidental-medical protection for the student on the school premises during

a regular school day; while he is being transported by the school district; and while the student is participating in any activity program on the school grounds sponsored by the school district, and while under the supervision of a certified teacher.

First day of school for all students will be Wednesday, Sept. 11.

Physiology and life science courses will be offered this semester to provide a more extensive coverage for the biological sciences.
