On motion of Supervisor Kenneth Hahn, the Board of Supervisors has pledged its full support to the Los Angeles Urban League "Back to School, Stay in School" campaign.

The Urban League is sponsoring the campaign to encourage all students, especially those of minority races, to complete their education so they may take their place in business and industry.

"In spite of the increasing demand for skilled workers, a large number of students drop out of high school before they receive adequate education and training," Hahn noted.

Favorite of Teenagers

For ground beef that makes light, tender and juicy hamburgers, have your beef ground to order by the butcher, and ask him to put it through the grinder just once.

HAMBURGER BARBECUE-STYLE

- 2 lbs. beef chuck, ground
- 1/4 cup coarse ground black pepper
- 1 can condensed tomato soup
- 1/2 tsp. sugar
- 2 tbsp. vinegar
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 1/4 cup Lea & Perrins Worcestershire sauce

Sprinkle hamburger with pepper and mix lightly. Shape into 8 cakes or patties. Quickly brown hamburger patties on both sides on hot skillet. In small saucepan, combine remaining ingredients and bring to a quick boil. Put hot sauce over browned hamburgers. Simmer over low to moderate heat about 15-20 minutes, until done as desired. Cook longer for very well done patties. (Makes 4 servings, or 8 patties with sauce.) If desired, these hamburgers may be prepared ahead of time and reheated for serving on platter or barbecue. Serve on soft hamburger buns for easy eating.
