## Student and Civic Groups Applaud New Sidewalk

A temporary asphalt sidewalk provided at Supervisor Kenneth Hahn's direction on 223rd street between Vermont and Normandie avenues has been warmly applauded by student and civic groups.

Hahn authorized the sidewalk on the north side of the street for the benefit and safety of students of 223rd Street School and Stephen M. White Junior High School.

It is one of several small but important improvements the Supervisor has made in Carson area since it became a part of his district in June. "On behalf of the student body of Stephen M. White Junior High School, we, the student body officers, would like to thank you for the sidewalks on 223rd St. Besides being convenient for the students, they are also helpful safety measures too," wrote Wayne Maddock, student body president.

The letter was also signed by Sandy Takahama, girls' vice president; Duane Maddock, boys vice president;

Sharon Murakami, secretary; and Tom Thayer, lower division vice president.

Paul Schneider, president of the Carson Chamber of Commerce, also wrote Hahn on behalf of the Chamber thanking him for authorizing the sidewalk.

Referring to a recent unexpected rain, Schneider pointed out the sidewalk enabled school children to use the walkway instead of the street, which they were forced to do previously because the walk was virtually

a mud hole.

"I would especially like to thank you for the quick service that we have received from your office since the northern section of the Carson area was placed in the Second District," Schneider added.

Supervisor Hahn pointed out the asphalt sidewalk is temporary and will be replaced by permanent curbs and sidewalks when this section of 223rd St. is improved by the county.

Currently underway is the improvement of the street between Vermont Ave. and Figueroa.

Included in this widening project is the construction of sidewalks on both sides of 223rd St.


