## Local Utilities Rates Lowest in Nation

Rates of California gas, electric and telephone utilities still are among the lowest in the nation, it was announced today by William M. Bennett, president of the State Public Utilities Commission. He said this was shown by the annual survey made by the Commission of basic monthly charges for service in the nation's 25 largest cities as of last June 30.

The survey shows the total monthly bill based on usage of 50 therms of gas, 150 kilowatt hours of electric energy and individual line residential telephone service. The 10 percent federal excise tax on telephone service is not included.

For the specified amounts of service San Franciscans, as of June 30, 1963, paid a total of \$14.01 which made it next to the lowest of the nation's major cities. Los Angeles is third low with a \$14.30 total and San Diego fourteenth with a total monthly bill of \$16.61.

Among the other 22 cities the total bill per month for the same amounts of service ranged from the low of \$13.59 in San Antonio, Texas, to a high of \$24.73 in Boston. Only five cities paid less than \$15 per month.

Telephone charges for one-party flat rate residential service were lowest in the three California cities.

Los Angeles' basic rate was \$4.55 per month, while San Diegans paid \$4.90 and San Franciscans \$5.05 for the individual residential line. In other cities the charge for the same service ranged up to \$7.70.




