Hot Hors d'oeuvres
Most women feel that when it comes to entertaining they'd rather do all preparation of foods earlier in the day so they can relax and enjoy the fun with their guests.

The idea of serving hot hors d'oeuvres is often rejected in favor of something "less last minute," something that won't need last minute attention. Now all that has been changed by features on modern gas ranges. It's possible now to prepare even hot hors d'oeuvres and canapes before the guests arrive.

The low temperature oven and automatic top burner will keep foods hot until you are ready to serve. Of course, the same is true for entire meals—prepare them ahead, clean up the pots and pans, and keep the food hot in serving dishes (even your finest china) at a temperature setting of 170 deg. to 180 deg. No longer need the guests wait for dinner or eat before they're ready—now the dinner will wait for them!

Try these recipes — or your own favorite — and keep them hot in the lo-temp oven or automatic top burner after cooking till you're ready to serve.

Jiffy Onion Cheese Bread
½ cup grated onion
1 Tbsp. butter or margarine
1½ cup biscuit mix
1 cup grated cheddar cheese
½ cup milk
-1 egg, beaten
Saute onion in butter or medium flame on automatic top burner set at 350 deg. until transparent (3 to 5 min.). Blend mix, grated cheese, milk, beaten egg, and sauteed onion into the well. Stir only until mix is moistened.

Spread dough in a greased 11"x7"x1½" baking pan. Sprinkle remaining cheese and 1 Tbsp. nippy seed over top of dough. Bake at 400 deg. for 20 to 25 minutes. Keep warm at 170 deg. in the lo-temp gas oven.

Stuffed Dates
Place rectangles of sharp cheddar cheese in pitted dates. Wrap in bacon (about 1/3 strip per date) and secure with toothpick.

Broil (bottom side of date first) 3 minutes per side with the top of the food 3" from top of flame and close the broiler door. When bacon is crisp remove dates from broiler and place in lo-temp gas oven set at 170 deg. until time to serve.

Hot Cheesy Shrimp Dip
1 pkg. garlic flavored soft cheese
1 can frozen shrimp soup
1 small can mushrooms—stems and pieces
Heat all ingredients on automatic top burner set at 175 deg. Serve with crackers.
