THINGS TO SEE IN SOUTHLAND

The Greater Western Exposition and Livestock Show in Los Angeles and El Cajon's 17th Annual Mother Goose Parade top the list of things to see in the Southland this week. Here is the schedule of activities in the area for the period of Nov. 14 through Nov. 23 as compiled by the Automobile Club of Southern California.

"People of the Valley," an exhibit of textiles and costumes of the 1870's, will be featured at the Los Angeles State and County Arboretum during the month of November.

The Padua Hills Theatre, Claremont, will present "Las Posadas," the traditional Mexican Christmas play, through Jan. 4.

Mother Goose Parade
The 17th annual Mother Goose Parade, held annually in El Cajon, to mark the beginning of the Christmas season in this community, will be held in Nov. Featured will be floats depicting famous Mother Goose characters.

Hollywood Park, Inglewood, Harness Racing will be held through Nov. 16.

"Flower Portraits," an exhibit of original art by Ethe-lynde Smith, will be featured in the Descanso Gardens, La Canada, Hospitality House from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. through Dec. 2.

The Long Beach Diamond Jubilee Celebrity Ball will be held in the Long Beach Arena at 8:30 p.m. Nov. 15.

Ice Capades Revue
The Ice Capades Revue will be in the Long Beach Arena from Nov. 19 through 24.

The Masterworks of Mexican Art will be featured in the Los Angeles County Museum through Jan. 1964. This is the largest and most comprehensive exhibition ever organized of the history of Mexican art covering over 3,000 years and containing over 2,000 objects. For the last two years, the exhibition has toured most of the major capitals of Europe.

The L.A. Museum will also feature an exhibit titled "The Old Navy," a history of the U.S. Navy in paintings, sketches and watercolors, from Nov. 16 through Dec. 15. Chamber music is provided each Sunday at 3 p.m. in the Museum.

The Character of Korea will be the theme of the exhibit at the Los Angeles City Hall Tower Gallery Art Exhibit through Nov. 27.
