Sheridan Memorial Race Slated for Ascot Park

The 1st annual Jim Sheridan Memorial 100-lap open competition race will be held Saturday night on the half-mile clay oval at Ascot Park in Gardena.

The event promises to be one of the top annual events locally, with more than \$3000 up for grabs. Since it's an open race, all types of cars are eligible to enter and fans will see sprint cars, sportsman, super modifieds and hot rods all running in the same race.

More than 100 cars are expected to enter, with the fastest 40 going in the 100-lap main event that will bring \$750 to the winner.

One of the top contenders will be Jim Oskie of Los Angeles in a red hot sportsman, however, super modified George Durade, also of Los Angeles, has been poised as the early favorite of his consistent showings the past several weeks.

Durade and the rest of his "flying wing" super modified drivers have been looking forward to this race for a chance to prove they can outdrive the sprinters and sportsman.

Two other top ranking drivers that filed early entries are Al Pombo of Fresno, 1963 NASCAR super modified champion, and Jack Clagg of San Diego, Sportsman champion.
