

Supervisor Reschedules Carson Park Dedication

Dedication ceremonies for Carson Neighborhood Park at 21411 South Orrick Ave. have been rescheduled for Saturday, Dec. 7, at 10:15 a.m., Supervisor Kenneth Hahn announced this week.

The civic ceremonies, originally scheduled for Nov. 23, were immediately cancelled by Supervisor Hahn when he learned of the death of President John F. Kennedy Nov. 22.

The Supervisor said today that all residents of Carson area have been invited to the dedication and the program will be exactly as previously announced.

Paul Schneider, president of the Carson Chamber of Commerce will be Master of Ceremonies.

Music will be provided by the Carson High School "Colt" Band, directed by Douglas Scott, and the Senatorettis, a choral group from Stephen M. White Junior High School, under the direction of Richard Schraier.

Highlight of the ceremony will be the presentation by Supervisor Hahn of a gold key to Mrs. Frank Whitmore, president of the Carson Elementary School PTA. The key will symbolize the opening of the park to all area residents, especially children, and Mrs. Whitmore will accept the key on behalf of the community.

A large scroll which all persons attending the ceremony will be asked to sign will be permaplaqued and placed on permanent display at the park's Recreation-Activity Building.
