

USAF Offers Opportunity For Medical Specialists

College students who are working toward a degree in Occupational or Physical Therapy may find welcome news in the "Medical Specialist Student Program" now offered by the Air Force.

The program, open to female students only, provides an opportunity for qualified applicants to draw full pay and allowances of an Air Force Second Lieutenant during the senior year of a four year course leading to a degree in Occupational or Physical Therapy, in approved schools. Upon completion of her studies the applicant is required to serve on active duty with the Air Force for two years.

AF Commission

According to S/Sgt. Ray Stauble, local Air Force recruiter, accepted applicants are commissioned as Air Force officers but will wear civilian clothes while attending school. The student therapist is required to pay tuition fees and other expenses but she will receive second lieutenant's pay and allowances the same as if she were on active duty.

Sergeant Stauble also emphasized that the same program is open to students possessing bachelor's degrees who meet the academic prerequisites and have been accepted for a 12-month certificate course in an approved school of Occupational or Physical Therapy. Students who possess bachelor's degrees and have been accepted for training in an approved hospital Dietetic Internship are also eligible to apply. In these cases the students are paid while completing the certificate course or serving the Dietetic Internship.

Must Be Citizen

In order to qualify, an applicant must be a citizen of the United States, between
